Zec. 4:6 "This is the word of the Lord Not by might, nor by power, but by my Spirit, saith the LORD of hosts."

And immediately Jesus stretched forth his hand, and caught him, and said unto him, O thou of little faith, wherefore didst thou doubt?”

[1] THAT THE FEAR OF GOD WOULD BE IN THEIR LIVES.

Pr.1:7 “The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge: but fools despise wisdom and instruction.”
