1. A Jesus Church will be a PEACEFUL Church

2 Chronicles 6:40 - 7:1 “Now, my God, let, I beseech thee, thine eyes be open, and let thine ears be attent unto the prayer that is made in this place. Now therefore arise, O LORD God, into thy resting place, thou, and the ark of thy strength: let thy priests, O LORD God, be clothed with salvation, and let thy saints rejoice in goodness. O LORD God, turn not away the face of thine anointed: remember the mercies of David thy servant. Now when Solomon had made an end of praying, the fire came down from heaven, and consumed the burnt offering and the sacrifices; and the glory of the LORD filled the house.”

2. A Jesus Church will not be a PROUDFUL Church.

3. A Jesus Church will be a POWERFUL Church.

4. A Jesus Church will be a PLENTIFUL Church.

Acts 1:8 “But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.”

Acts 2:32 “This Jesus hath God raised up, whereof we all are witnesses.”

5. A Jesus Church will be a PRAYERFUL Church.

Matthew 21:13 “And [Jesus] said unto them, It is written, My house shall be called the house of prayer...”

Acts 1:14 “These all continued with one accord in prayer and supplication, with the women, and Mary the mother of Jesus, and with his brethren.”

6. A Jesus Church will be a PREACHING Church.

2 Timothy 4:1-4 “I charge thee therefore before God, and the Lord Jesus Christ, who shall judge the quick and the dead at his appearing and his kingdom; **Preach the word**; be instant in season, out of season; **reprove, rebuke, exhort** with all longsuffering and doctrine. **For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine**; but **after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears**; **And they shall turn away their ears from the truth, and shall be turned unto fables.**”

Mark. 6:12 “And they went out and **preached** that men should **repent.**”

1 Corinthians 2:4-5 “And my **speech** and my **preaching** was **not** with **enticing words of man's wisdom**, but in **demonstration of the Spirit and of power**: That your **faith** should **not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God.**”

2 Corinthians 4:5 “For we **preach not ourselves**, but **Christ Jesus the Lord**; and ourselves your **servants** for **Jesus' sake.**”

Galatians 1:10 “For do I now persuade **men**, or **God**? or **do I seek to please men**? for **if I yet pleased men, I should not be the servant of Christ.**”

7. A Jesus Church will be a PURPOSEFUL Church.

Luke 14:23 “And **the lord said** unto the **servant**, **Go** out into the **highways** and **hedges**, and **compel them to come in, that my house may be filled.**”

Luke 19:10 “For the Son of man is come to **seek and to save that which was lost.**”
